

## Student Wellbeing Clinic

Dear Parent/Carer,

We currently provide a health service in school to all Yr10, Yr11 and Sixth Form students. As of Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2017, this weekly drop in facility known as 'THE STUDENT WELLBEING CLINIC' will be accessible to Yr9 also. The drop in service will be open every Tuesday, operate during the hours of 12.55pm - 1.55pm and be overseen by our Specialist Public Health School Nurse Team. They are qualified to offer our students confidential advice and support in the field of Sex and Relationship Education (SRE) including;

- General advice
- Counselling
- Relationships
- Lifestyle Choices
- Condoms
- Contraception
- Emergency contraception
- Pregnancy tests
- Chlamydia screening
- Referrals to GP or Suffolk Sexual Health - Trotman Court Clinic, Orwell Clinic, Lindburgh Road, Ipswich IP4 1BN where appropriate.

We will be launching this service to Year 9 via an assembly on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> December 2016. This launch **follows** the delivery of our very extensive and comprehensive **SRE PSHEE modules throughout the Autumn Term.**

We see this as a positive feature of our pastoral care and coupled with our SRE delivery across PSHEE (Personal, Social, Health & Economic Education) hope to support our youngsters in making informed decisions about their own personal wellbeing, health and approaches to relationships as they mature into young adults. This service is now very well established within the school and has proven to be very successful in meeting the needs of the students.
